When

Father's day June 15th 2014 - weigh in at 9.00 am. Skippers meeting 9.30 am, with racing commencing at 10.00 am. No race will start after 4.00 pm.

Where

Deception Pass State Park, at our beach on Cranberry Lake, wet launch in fresh water. Or the Bowman bay pier if the wind is from the west, dry launch in salt water. A Discover Pass or park entry fee is required to access any of the park facilities. Maps and camping reservations at www.parks.wa.gov.

Lunch will be provided. All skippers and helpers are invited to an after race pot luck buffet and awards immediately after racing.

Eligibility

Sailors with a one metre R/C sailboat that wish to have a fun fathers day in an outstanding park that have paid the \$40.00 entry are eligible to compete.

Current AMYA membership or equivalent is encouraged .All boats will be weighed in – fully rigged, with battery, fin, bulb and rudder attached and should be above the minimum weight for their class.
