

Seattle MYC Regatta #2 – IOM Class (April 16, 2016 @ Coulon Park)

Bob Wells Reporting & Jerry Brower Scoring:

This time we had unusually warm sunny weather and a light wind from the NW with flat water, and crowded starting lines. It was so light at times we couldn't race. Kelly made his first appearance at Coulon this year, and showed us how to do it once again. After Kelly it was closely contested for each position. Larry Stiles had his first outing with his new "orange" Astbury Britpop, and after a doggy first two races he sorted things out quickly – good enough to squeak out 2nd place. At the end of the day nobody was higher or faster than Larry upwind in the light wind.

Another 'newish' boat was Joe Damico's Kantun SMX, in day-glo red-orange livery. Blame David Jensen for the color, as this is the 1st Kantun SMX David received that had a fin to hull interface problem. Joe purchased the boat and fixed the issues, and then rearranged his sheeting system on deck, similar to his Britpop. The boat looks clean now, and is obviously fast as Joe placed third – somehow again he was pipped by one point! Joe likes the bright color – now he can easily pick it out in a crowd. David is sailing his replacement Kantun SMX, which he is quite happy with (thank you Brighton Boat Works for making it right). Unfortunately it is that same day-glo red-orange color – a color so intense that it vibrates in sunlight.

Yet another new Kantun SMX was sailed by Ron Hornung – a black one. This is a loaner from Jerry Brower's fleet, and he rigged his sheeting system on deck too, similar to his "orange" V9. In the Ron versus Jerry contest (with Jerry's boats) the winner is – Ron Hornung by a convincing 6 points in 5th place. Don't you just hate it when you loan somebody your boat and they beat you. This time Ron didn't put his receiver down to shoot photos, which helps his scores. And for the record, Jerry left two races early for a long 8-hour drive to compete in BC's Coastal Cup #2 in Port Alberni on the west side of Vancouver island. Jerry represented us well in Canada on Sunday.

It is notable that in our little fleet 7 of the 19 boats racing are the Kantun S (or the SMX from the same mold) designed by Zvonko Jelacic and Robert Grubisa. The Kantun S is from Jelacic Sailing in Croatia. The Kantun SMX is by MX Components (Maurizio Morbidelli, ITA), molded nicely by Thai Safepack (Thailand), and distributed in the US by Brighton Boat Works (Tom Brighton in SoCal). After some sorting, all the Kantuns are sailing fast. Actually our whole fleet seems faster to me, and it only took us five years to get here. We are not done improving either... One key is we get together after each race and enjoy our favorite beverage and laugh and tell lies.

Our COW regatta is next weekend, and the forecast is back to normal temps with rain – subject to change of course. We should have wind at least and weed is very minor this time of year.
