2025 Seattle MYC Regatta #1 – IOM Class (March 29th at Coulon Park in Renton, WA) Bob Wells Reporting and Mike Hansow Scoring:

I was excited about this Coulon regatta because two weeks ago the Gig Harbor #1 IOM regatta was such great fun in serious wind. The forecast was 6 knots with 20 knot gusts, and this was that rare time when we actually got the predicted gusts. In fact, 3 of the 8 boats spent time in B-rig, which is unheard of on Surprise Lake.

SMYC #1 had a similar forecast, and this peaked my interest. Per usual, we got the predicted wind (which was great) and without the big gusts (who wants 20 knot gusts in A-rig anyway). It made for some very close racing in flat water with clouds and some late sun peaking in thru the clouds. Finishes were topsy turvy even though the wind was pretty solid with few holes. The top 7 proved close in speed and pointing, so tactics at starts and marks created the separation. Make an inadvertent error, and half the bunched fleet or more pass you. 75% of the fleet had a 1st place, and everybody had a last or next-to-last, which is the definition of topsy turvy fleet racing. That said, Peter Conze had impressive consistency after a challenging beginning with Tx trim issues. The race was for 2nd, and it was contested as only 7 points separated 2 thru 6. 2nd place went to the 15-year-old *Fusion*, the oldest boat in the fleet and a prototype design by Craig Smith in Oz that didn't test well enough to be a series build. Often Protos are thrown together quickly to test the hull, but the *Fusion* is a refined IOM with obvious care.

25% of the fleet sailed woodies, and both were *Panacea's* designed and build by local David Jensen. This was Daryl Ruff's maiden race with his new P4 *Panacea*, that was purchased last week. Daryl sails faster with his new woodie, that we have determined already.

For our late lunch after sailing, we walked to Ivar's, where we watched Mike send out the scores before he took his first bite. Them back to were telling lies and laughing at ourselves.

Gig Harbor MYC and Seattle MYC Funding:

Gig Harbor MYC and SMYC have evolved to function as combined clubs with shared venues and with organizers and skippers supporting each other. We have no dues, meetings or even organizer titles, as it is all about the sailing and camaraderie. This only works because folks step up as needed. We no longer have a treasurer, and we thank JWB for his many years of service in that capacity. We still have expenses to run our Coulon regattas, and Mike Hansow stepped up and is covering this outof-pocket as he did in 2024. To share the costs, I propose we continue last year's donation suggestion, when you sail more, you pay more (and vice versa):

I suggest skippers voluntarily directly pay Mike <u>\$10/regatta or \$100 max</u> when you race outside the Coulon Waterwalk using the regatta gear he provides. My suggestion breaks down like this if you attend every anticipated regatta:

(3)DF95 regattas1 club event & 2 Regional Champs days(10)IOM SMYC regattas8 club event & 2 Regional Champs days13 total X \$10 = \$130 total(\$100 max) to Mike (if you sail every event)

Since I expect to sail in all the Coulon Regattas, I'll voluntarily discreetly reimburse Mike \$100 for 2025. If you don't know how many opportunities you'll have to sail, it makes sense to wait till the end of the year to reimburse Mike. The goal is not to cover all Mike's costs, but to cover all his annual costs plus a partial payment on his initial purchase of Joe's Damico's wonderful kit.

You can voluntarily pay Mike discretely at the pond or mail him a check (contact Bob Wells or Mike if you need his address).
